

## ***Scriptures for Declaration...***

*For by your words you will be justified, and by your words you will be condemned (Matthew 12:37)*

### **THE WORD**

Psalm 1: 1-3 -- Blessed is the man who walks not in the counsel of the ungodly, Nor stands in the path of sinners, Nor sits in the seat of the scornful; But his delight is in the law of the LORD, and in His law he meditates day and night. He shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that brings forth its fruit in its season, whose leaf also shall not wither; and whatever he does shall prosper.

Psalm 37:4, 23 -- Delight yourself also in the LORD, and He shall give you the desires of your heart. The steps of a good man are ordered by the LORD, And He delights in his way.

Psalm 107:20 -- He sent His word and healed them, and delivered them from their destructions.

Psalm 23:4 -- Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil; For You are with me; Your rod and Your staff, they comfort me.

Psalm 119:89 -- Forever, O LORD, Your word is settled in heaven.

Proverbs 16:3 -- Commit your works to the LORD, and your thoughts will be established.

Proverbs 18:7 -- A fool's mouth is his destruction, and his lips are the snare of his soul.

Proverbs 16:9, 24 -- A man's heart plans his way, but the LORD directs his steps. Pleasant words are like a honeycomb, Sweetness to the soul and health to the bones.

Isaiah 55:11 -- So shall My word be that goes forth from My mouth; It shall not return to Me void, But it shall accomplish what I please, And it shall prosper in the thing for which I sent it.

Mark 11:23 -- For assuredly, I say to you, whoever says to this mountain, 'Be removed and be cast into the sea,' and does not doubt in his heart, but believes that those things he says will be done, he will have whatever he says.

Romans 10:18 -- But I say, have they not heard? Yes indeed: "Their sound has gone out to all the earth, and their words to the ends of the world."

### **WISDOM**

Colossians 1:19 -- For it pleased the Father that in Him all the fullness should dwell,

Proverbs 4:20-23 -- My son, give attention to my words; Incline your ear to my sayings. Do not let them depart from your eyes;  
Keep them in the midst of your heart; for they are life to those who find them, and health to all their flesh.  
Keep your heart with all diligence, for out of it spring the issues of life.

Proverbs 10:22 -- The blessing of the LORD makes one rich, and He adds no sorrow with it.

Proverbs 12:14,18,28 -- A man will be satisfied with good by the fruit of his mouth, and the recompense of a man's hands will be rendered to him. There is one who speaks like the piercings of a sword, but the tongue of the wise promotes health.  
In the way of righteousness is life, and in its pathway there is no death.

## **ACTION (TO DO)**

James 1:22 -- But be doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves.

Ephesians 6:16 -- above all, taking the shield of faith with which you will be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked one.

Galatians 3:13 -- Christ has redeemed us from the curse of the law, having become a curse for us (for it is written, "Cursed is everyone who hangs on a tree")

Romans 8:11 -- But if the Spirit of Him who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you, He who raised Christ from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through His Spirit who dwells in you.

Matthew 16:19 -- And I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven, and whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven."

Proverbs 21:23 -- Whoever guards his mouth and tongue keeps his soul from troubles.

Proverbs 10:11 -- The mouth of the righteous is a well of life, But violence covers the mouth of the wicked.

Proverbs 12:6,14 -- The words of the wicked are, "Lie in wait for blood," But the mouth of the upright will deliver them.

## **PROTECTION**

Hebrews 1:14 -- Are they not all ministering spirits sent forth to minister for those who will inherit salvation?

Romans 10:17 -- So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

Psalms 27:1 -- The LORD is my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear?  
The LORD is the strength of my life; of whom shall I be afraid?

Psalms 118:17 -- I shall not die, but live, and declare the works of the LORD.

## **FAMILY**

Deuteronomy 28:1-14 -- "Now it shall come to pass, if you diligently obey the voice of the LORD your God, to observe carefully all His commandments which I command you today, that the LORD your God will set you high above all nations of the earth. <sup>2</sup> And all these blessings shall come upon you and overtake you, because you obey the voice of the LORD your God:

<sup>3</sup> “Blessed shall you be in the city, and blessed shall you be in the country.

<sup>4</sup> “Blessed shall be the fruit of your body, the produce of your ground and the increase of your herds, the increase of your cattle and the offspring of your flocks.

<sup>5</sup> “Blessed shall be your basket and your kneading bowl.

<sup>6</sup> “Blessed shall you be when you come in, and blessed shall you be when you go out.

<sup>7</sup> “The LORD will cause your enemies who rise against you to be defeated before your face; they shall come out against you one way and flee before you seven ways.

<sup>8</sup> “The LORD will command the blessing on you in your storehouses and in all to which you set your hand, and He will bless you in the land which the LORD your God is giving you.

<sup>9</sup> “The LORD will establish you as a holy people to Himself, just as He has sworn to you, if you keep the commandments of the LORD your God and walk in His ways. <sup>10</sup> Then all peoples of the earth shall see that you are called by the name of the LORD, and they shall be afraid of you. <sup>11</sup> And the LORD will grant you plenty of goods, in the fruit of your body, in the increase of your livestock, and in the produce of your ground, in the land of which the LORD swore to your fathers to give you. <sup>12</sup> The LORD will open to you His good treasure, the heavens, to give the rain to your land in its season, and to bless all the work of your hand. You shall lend to many nations, but you shall not borrow. <sup>13</sup> And the LORD will make you the head and not the tail; you shall be above only, and not be beneath, if you heed the commandments of the LORD your God, which I command you today, and are careful to observe them. <sup>14</sup> So you shall not turn aside from any of the words which I command you this day, to the right or the left, to go after other gods to serve them.

Isaiah 54:13,14,17 -- All your children shall be taught by the LORD, And great shall be the peace of your children. In righteousness you shall be established; you shall be far from oppression, for you shall not fear; and from terror, for it shall not come near you. No weapon formed against you shall prosper, and every tongue which rises against you in judgment you shall condemn. This is the heritage of the servants of the LORD, and their righteousness is from Me,” says the LORD.

Malachi 3:10-11 -- Bring all the tithes into the storehouse, that there may be food in My house, And try Me now in this,” says the LORD of hosts, “If I will not open for you the windows of heaven And pour out for you such blessing That there will not be room enough to receive it.

<sup>11</sup> “And I will rebuke the devourer for your sakes, so that he will not destroy the fruit of your ground, Nor shall the vine fail to bear fruit for you in the field,” says the LORD of hosts;

## **VICTORY**

Ephesians 4:23 -- and be renewed in the spirit of your mind,

2 Corinthians 10:3-5 -- For though we walk in the flesh, we do not war according to the flesh. <sup>4</sup> For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal but mighty in God for pulling down strongholds, <sup>5</sup> casting down arguments and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God, bringing every thought into captivity to the obedience of Christ,

John 16:13 -- However, when He, the Spirit of truth, has come, He will guide you into all truth; for He will not speak on His own authority, but whatever He hears He will speak; and He will tell you things to come.

Proverbs 16:3 -- Commit your works to the LORD, And your thoughts will be established.

Romans 5:17 -- For if by the one man's offense death reigned through the one, much more those who receive abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness will reign in life through the One, Jesus Christ.)

## **PROSPERITY**

Deuteronomy 8:18 -- And you shall remember the LORD your God, for it is He who gives you power to get wealth, that He may establish His covenant which He swore to your fathers, as it is this day.

Deuteronomy 11:12 -- a land for which the LORD your God cares; the eyes of the LORD your God are always on it, from the beginning of the year to the very end of the year.

Deuteronomy 28:2 -- And all these blessings shall come upon you and overtake you, because you obey the voice of the LORD your God:

Proverbs 3:9-10 -- Honor the LORD with your possessions, And with the firstfruits of all your increase; So your barns will be filled with plenty, And your vats will overflow with new wine.

Psalms 1:3 -- He shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that brings forth its fruit in its season, whose leaf also shall not wither; and whatever he does shall prosper.

Luke 6:38 -- Give, and it will be given to you: good measure, pressed down, shaken together, and running over will be put into your bosom. For with the same measure that you use, it will be measured back to you."

Psalms 107:20 -- He sent His word and healed them, and delivered them from their destructions.

2 Peter 1:3,4 -- as His divine power has given to us all things that pertain to life and godliness, through the knowledge of Him who called us by glory and virtue, <sup>4</sup> by which have been given to us exceedingly great and precious promises, that through these you may be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust.

Psalms 19:7 -- The law of the LORD is perfect, converting the soul; the testimony of the LORD is sure, making wise the simple;

John 15:7 -- If you abide in Me, and My words abide in you, you will ask what you desire, and it shall be done for you.

Psalms 107:19-20 -- Then they cried out to the LORD in their trouble, and He saved them out of their distresses. He sent His word and healed them, and delivered them from their destructions.

Isaiah 53:5-6 -- But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities; the chastisement for our peace was upon Him, And by His stripes we are healed. All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned, every one, to his own way; and the LORD has laid on Him the iniquity of us all.

1 Peter 2:24 -- Who Himself bore our sins in His own body on the tree, that we, having died to sins, might live for righteousness—by whose stripes you were healed.
